



## ANGEL How to Ensure that Student Submissions are not made as GUEST

### Abstract:

Since ANGEL (hosted by SLN) is designed to “Time Out” for users who are **inactive** for a period of time, student accounts will be MOVED from the student’s account name to “GUEST” if they keep ANGEL open on their computer but ‘walk away’ or remain inactive for long periods of time.

The system does NOT log them off, it just *changes* their account status to GUEST.

**Students will not notice this** and may then submit work that is received as from “Guest” rather than themselves.

**To prevent** student work being submitted as “GUEST”, (particularly assignment drop boxes, quizzes and discussions), for each of these in your course, Go to the “Access” tab and under View Restrictions – “Viewable by”, select “**Students**” instead of “Everyone”. Don’t forget to “Save” after this change.
