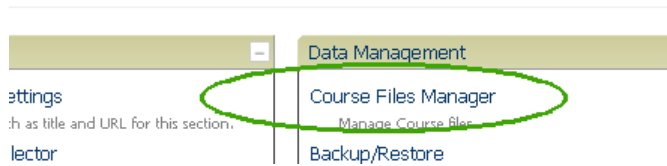


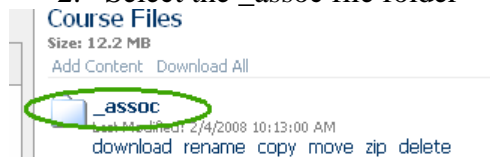
ANGEL INSTRUCTIONS TO RE-LINK to content that is disassociated with Blackboard-converted references

(Abstract: When exporting Blackboard course content, and Importing into Angel, some files become disassociated with the links to them in the course. This can be documents or images. These instructions are a guide to re-associating the link to the original file now in Angel NOTE: These instructions are also valid for content moved from Lotus Notes).

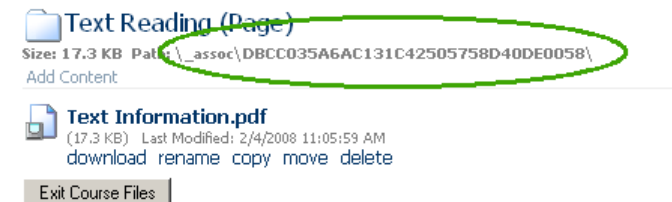
1. Go to Manage, and Select “Course File Manager” under the Data Management nugget.



2. Select the _assoc file folder



3. Locate the file you want to connect to, and record the file ID number.

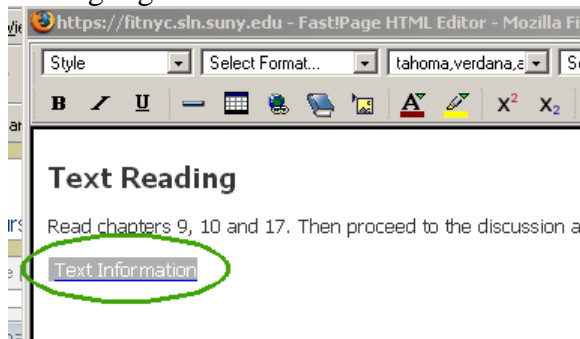

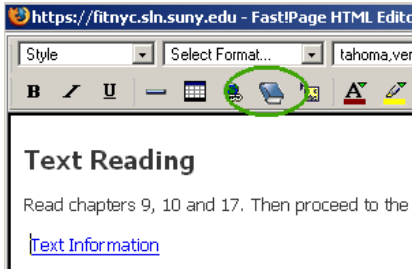

4. In the Learning Modules area, open the page with the disassociated content. Select “Settings” and Choose HTML Editor. (activate with the cursor and space bar in the white area)

5. Highlight the link to the content that is not working.



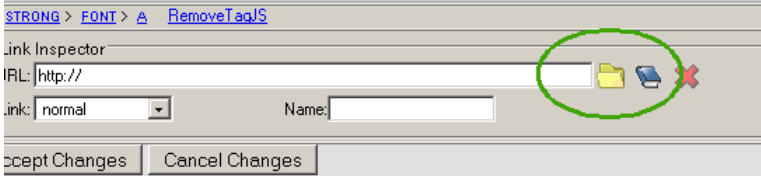
6. Select the Book Link.



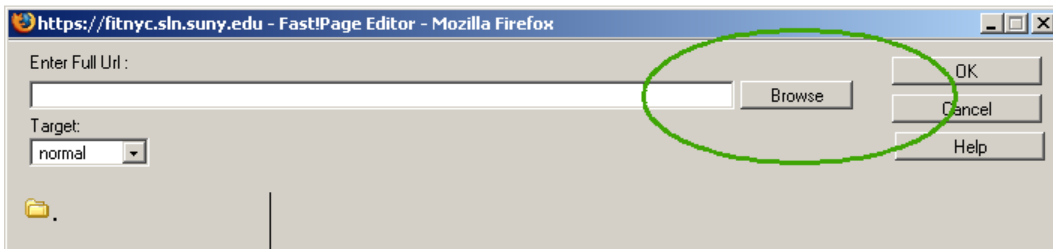
7. Close the popup browser panel

8. Select the Folder link at bottom of page

◆ Dividend payout of 40%



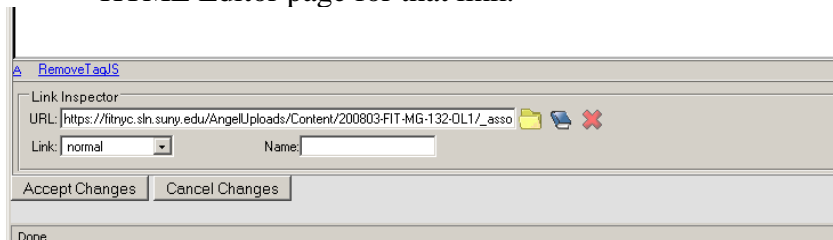
9. Select Browse at the "Enter Full URL" search line at the top of the window.



10. Go to the **assoc** directory and find the file name with the matching file ID number. Click on that file ID number and the URL for the file will pop into the Browse file name bar. (see below)



11. Select OK to accept the file location into the URL Bar at the bottom of the HTML Editor page for that link.



12. Select "Accept Changes", then Select "Save" for the link to work.

You can test the link by clicking on the link. The associated file should now open.
