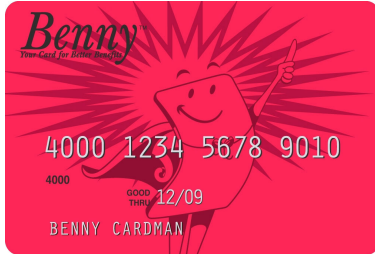

## Benny™ Prepaid

## Benefit Card ?

Many of you have already found out how convenient it is to pay your co-payment with your benefit card at the doctor's office, the vision care provider and the dentist. BUT, did you know that you are able to use your card at a variety of merchants for prescriptions and over-the-counter products where a standardized coding system (Inventory Information Approval System - IIAS codes) has been implemented. ## WHAT'S THE BOZZ QUESTIONS and more QUESTIONS !

**Q. "I received two cards in the mail, was that a mistake?"**

A. No, that was not a mistake. Every Benny Card customer receives two cards. If you only need one, destroy the extra one. The extra card can be used by a spouse or a dependent. Just have them sign the back of the card before using it.

**Q. "How do I sign up for the Benny Card?"**

A. Your employer's payroll office or human resource office should have an application. If not, have them call PGP and we will send them one. After PGP receives the application, it will take about 10 days to receive your cards in the mail.

**Q. "How do I activate my Card?"**

A. The easiest way to activate a card is to call the 800 number on the sticker that comes with your new card. You can also go online to [www.mybenny.com](http://www.mybenny.com). You will need your SSN to log on. Once you establish an account, you can activate your card. You can always call PGP customer service at 800-573-7474 and they can activate the card for you.



**Q. "I get emails from Benny Central, but I can't open them. It asks for my password. What's that?"**

A. When you get an email from Benny Central it may contain sensitive information. Benny Central password protects that file to ensure your privacy. Your SSN is your password.



## NEW MILEAGE RATE

Flex Account Participants may be reimbursed for each mile a car is used for medical purposes. January 1, 2008 to June 30, 2008 the rate of 19 cents per mile may be paid for medical transportation and between July 1, 2008 and December 31, 2008 the rate of 27 cents may be paid for medical mileage. The rate had been 20 cents per mile in 2007 and 18 cents in 2006. **This reimbursement may be paid for transportation primarily for, and essential to, medical care from your medical flexible spending account.**
